**Account of A Voyage of Discovery:**

*To the west coast of Corea and the Great Loo-Choo Island with an appendix, containing charts and various hydrographical and scientific notices and a vocabulary of the Loo-Choo language.*

After taking Lord Amherst's Embassy in 1816 to China, the ships "Alceste" and "Lyra" started the expedition to the South China Sea. Captain Hall's account added considerable knowledge about little known Korea and described the Ryukyu Islands for the first time in detail. The fine colour plates of scenery and costumes were drawn by W.Havell after sketches made on the spot by crew members.
